CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

FRANK S. BUEHLER

of 1171 County Club Rd., Hood River , State of Oregon, 97031 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and Buehler Pond constructed under Permit No. R-6056

a tributary of Indian Creek for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 5.0 acres, recreation and fish culture

under Permit No. 37324 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.02 c.f.s. for recreation and fish culture from stream and pond

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M., 260 feet North and 400 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6056

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Recreation & Fish Culture 5.0 acres SE¼ NE¼ Section 4 T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
