This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM H. HARTWIG & GEORGE T. DEDES

of 487 Piller Place, Cave Junction , State of Oregon, 97523 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Illinois River and an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5301

a tributary of Illinois River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 15.2 acres and fish culture

under Permit No. 33558 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 8, 1968 for irrigation and October 9, 1968 for fish culture that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second, being 0.30 c.f.s. from West Fork Illinois River for irrigation and 0.09 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and reservoir for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $_4$ SW $_4$, SE $_4$ SW $_4$, Section 32, both as projected within Turner DLC 39, T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.; River-710 feet South and 80 feet West; Reservoir-1040 feet South and 600 feet West, both from the NE Corner, Turner DLC 39

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
