CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

DRY GULCH DITCH COMPANY

of Richland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Little Eagle Creek, tributary of Eagle Creek
 for the purpose of the irrigation of 572.52 ac. es of land

and that ~~Baker~~ right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1740, at page 291;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot
 per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Ten: 24 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 24 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fifteen: 20 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 25 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 20 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 6 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Sixteen: 4.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 16.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 25.52 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 30 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 21 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 15 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 24 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Seventeen: 12 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 2 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 3 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 7 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 11 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 25 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eighteen: 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Nineteen: 31.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 21 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 23 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 11 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 23 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 9 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty: 20 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 9.8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-one, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
