This Is to Certify, That

GEORGE DOLLOWITCH, SR.,

of P. O. Box 242, Waldport , State of Oregon, 97374 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two unnamed streams

a tributary of South Fork Big Creek irrigation of 6.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31141 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 16, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. from West stream and 0.05 c.f.s. from East stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4, Section 11 and NE4 NE4, Section 14, T. 14 S., R. 12 W., W. M., West stream-490 feet North and 1380 feet West; East stream-40 feet South and 460 feet West, both from NE Corner, Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre. Or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

West stream 2.0 acres SW4 SE4 Section 11

East stream
E4 4.0 acres NE4 NE4
Section 14
T. 14 S., R. 12 W.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
