CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JAMES ENGUM

of Richland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of EAGLE CREEK, and LITTLE EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Eagle Creek, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation of 183 acres of land:

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900 for 50.5 acres, 1879 for 113 acres in Tract No. 1; 1870 for 19.5 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: Twenty acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; twenty-seven acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter; forty acres Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 35.5 acres in Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter 25 acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-seven; sixteen acres in Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-eight;
Tract No. 2: Fifteen acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 4.5 acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-seven;
All the above described land being in Township Nine South, Range Forty-five east of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
