under Permit No. 39930 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 29, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.9 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN4 SN4, as projected within Blackerby DLC, Section 9, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 1480 feet North and 2620 feet East from the SW Corner, Blackerby DLC

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_of-one-cubic-foot-per-secondper\_acre, a diversion of 2½ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,
