CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That **GEORGE W. EVANS,**

of **Richland**, State of **Oregon**, has a right to the use of
the waters of **EAGLE CREEK**, a tributary of **Powder River**,
for the purpose of **irrigation of 80.3 acres of land;**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the **STATE WATER BOARD** of the State of Oregon, in Volume **six**, at page **291**;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from **1881 for 40.3 acres; 1886 for
40 acres;**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **one-fortieth of one**
cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

**Forty acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; forty acres in
Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty, Township Nine South,
Range Forty-six East of Willamette Meridian, and 0.3 acre in Lot Five, and
South half of Lot Three, in Block Three of the town of Richland, Baker County,
Oregon.**

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
