CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of P.O. Box 11097, Portland, State of Oregon, 97211, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Columbia Slough Drainage Canal for the purpose of industrial (curing concrete pipe)

under Permit No. G-5237 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.3 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W. M., 810 feet North and 1110 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
