## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MARVIN FAST

of Rt. 1, Box 147-A, Amity , State of Oregon, 97101 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Salt Creek and stored water from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5971

a tributary of Yamhill River irrigation of 103.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 36800 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1973 for stored water and July 25, 1973 for Salt Creek that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.3 cubic feat per second from Salt Creek and 35.0 acre feet stored water from unnamed drainageway

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE½ NW½, as projected within Riggs DLC 56, Section 32; NW½ NE½, as projected within Savory DLC 79, Section 31; Salt Creek-330 feet South and 1320 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 32; Holding Pond-640 feet South and 920 feet East from the N½ Corner, Section 31, T. 6 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5971,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
