## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ED JONES

of Rt. 1, Box 76, Drain , State of Oregon, 97435 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 2.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 20600 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_4$  NE4, Section 14, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 1710 feet South and 2330 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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2.8 acres SE4 SE4
Section 11
T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at the SE Corner of Section 1%, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M.; thence West 1320 feet, thence North 170 feet to south boundary of Umpqua Highway r/w, thence easterly to the point where said south boundary of Umpqua Highway intersects with the section line between Sections 11 and 12, T. 22 S., R. 5 W., W. M.; thence 236 feet South to the point of beginning. This above describes all property being south of highway r/w in SE½ SE½, Section 11, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M. and comprise 10.7 acres more or less.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director March 9, 1967 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 22702, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
