CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. E. DIMMICK

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic, stock, and irrigation of 1.0 acre

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1896

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per
second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

1.0 acre W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.


This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on
page 42922, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to
correctly describe the quantity of water.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
