## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
School House Creek and Woolfolk Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1662

a tributary of Little Butte Creek and Rogue River for the purpose of maintaining 304.5 acre feet of stored water in Woolfolk Reservoir for recreation and fish culture under Permit No. 23116 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.01 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SW4, Section 34, T. 35 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 700 feet North and 280 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to -----of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 41765, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 5, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3949.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
