or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN $\frac{1}{4}$ SN $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, T. 15 S., R. 5 W.,W. M., Reservoir-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SN $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M., River-2220 feet North and 930 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 23

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625 and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-7486 or a suitable replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.
