CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, Thatsamuel gover estate, matte gover, carson gover, vina gover, and woody gover,

, State of Oregon,

has a right to the use of

the waters of LAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River,

for the purpose of irrigation of 195 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page91; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879 for 71 acres; 1885 for 114 acres; 1885 for 10 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Ten acres in Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Ten; twenty-two acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; of Section Twenty-three; forty acres in Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; eleven acres in Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; thirty-eight acres in Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section twenty-six, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five east of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
