CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOSEPH HARTLEY,

of Richland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of LITTLE EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Eagle Creek, and EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation of 196.25 acres of land,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1868 for 5 acres; 1886 for 30 acres; 1881 for 161.25 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Thirty acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; of Section Nineteen forty acres in Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; forty acres in Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; forty acres in Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty; Township Nine South, Range Forty-six East of Willamette Meridian; Five acres in Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-six; one acre in North west quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-three; Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian; 0.25 acre in Lot Nine, Block Four, in the town of Richland, Baker County, Oregon.
