a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 47.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34098 and that said right to "2 use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1_4 SW 1_4 , as projected within Chapman DLC 43, Section 8, T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 1750 feet North and 2200 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres NE¼ SW¼ 13.6 acres SE¼ SW¼ Section 8 29.4 acres NE¼ NW¼ Section 17

All as projected within Chapman DLC 43

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded at page 46017, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correcly describe the location of the diversion point and place of use. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
