, State of Oregon, 97047 Parkdale. , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek and Eliot Creek

a tributary of Middle Fork Hood River irrigation of 4.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 36065 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 9, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 c.f.s. from Clear Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. from Eliot Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW½ NE½, Section 27, SW½ NE½, Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 9 E., W. M., Clear Creek - 520 feet South and 2500 feet West from NE Corner, Section 27, Eliot Creek - 2450 feet South and 2280 feet West from NE Corner, Section 26, SW½ SE½, Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 10 E., W. M.; Pump - 1180 feet North and 1100 feet East from the St Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 4.4 acres SW4 SE4 Section 19 T. 1 S., R. 10 E., W. M.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre and 4 acre feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been reduced to 1/80th cubic foot per second per acre and 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
