## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

*This Is to Certify, That*

CLYDE W. CONKLIN, JOHN INGLIS, E. H. KUNKEL

of Star Rt., Box 196-H, Winston, State of Oregon, 97496, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Hopkins Gulch, unnamed draw and reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-1058

a tributary of Stearling Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 15.7 acres and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 19669 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.195 cubic foot per second, being 0.13 c.f.s. for irrigation, 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from Hopkins Gulch and reservoir, and 0.055 c.f.s. from unnamed draw and reservoir for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 32, T. 38 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from April 2 to October 31 from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1058

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



It also describes that portion of the water right NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 18, 1977.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.*
