or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $_{4}$ NW $_{4}$, Section 30, T. 15 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 3650 feet North and 2850 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 30, T. 15 S., R. 4 W., W. M.
