## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

GEORGE W. &amp; MELINDA W. GRIER

of 1342½ N. 66th St., Springfield, State of Oregon, 97477, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cedar Creek

a tributary of McKenzie River for the purpose of irrigation of 48.8 acres

under Permit No. 35935 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¼ SE¼, as projected within McNutt DLC 75, Section 27, T. 17 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1480 feet South and 1310 feet West from the NE Corner, McNutt DLC 75

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.8 acres SW¼ NE¼  
 4.2 acres SE¼ NW¼  
 Both as projected within Whittaker DLC 51  
 3.0 acres SW¼ NE¼  
 5.5 acres SE¼ NW¼  
 19.1 acres NE¼ SW¼  
 9.2 acres NW¼ SE¼  
 All as projected within McNutt DLC 75  
 Section 27  
 T. 17 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
