## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**OREGON-WASHINGTON RAILROAD &  
NAVIGATION COMPANY

Attention: T. P. Rogers, General Manager  
of Box 4265, Portland, State of Oregon, 97208, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
a well

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of  
fire protection and emergency uses at Union Pacific Railroad Station of Castle

under Permit No. G-2806 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
January 14, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.  
The well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17, T. 4 N., R. 24 E., W. M., South 25  
degrees 54 minutes 43 seconds West, 2982.13 feet from the NE Corner, Section 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
