## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CECIL N. KINDEL

of Route 3, Box 609, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, 97123, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 22.4 acres

under Permit No. 24399 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 17, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Robertson DLC 50, Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.; 120 feet South and 210 feet West from the SW Corner, Webster DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
10.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
7.6 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$

All as projected within Robertson DLC 50  
Section 26  
T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Rights Department entered August 21, 1968, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 26874, Volume 19, State Records of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
