## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. C. JASPER,

of New Bridge , State of Oregon;

has a right to the use of

the waters of EAGLE CHEEK, a tributary of Powder River,

for the purpose of irrigation of 57.98 acres of land,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 for 55.28 acres, in tract No. 1; 1898 for 19.7 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed one-fortleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 8.2 acres in Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; of Section Eleven:
