CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ASSOCIATION OF UNIT OWNERS OF THE INN OF THE SEVENTH MOUNTAIN

610 Park Plaza West, of 10700 SW Beaverton HWY, Beaverton , State of Oregon, 97005 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 4.9 acres, domestic, commercial, maintenance of fire suppression under Permit No. G-5686 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second, being 0.10 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.11 c.f.s. for commercial, 0.05 c.f.s. for fire suppression, and 0.06 c.f.s for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 SW4, Section 22, T. 18 S., R. 11 E., W.M., 380 feet South and 1190 feet East from the NW Corner, SE4 SW4, Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, Fire, Commercial & 4.8 acres SE_4 SW_4 Domestic, Fire, Commercial & 0.1 acre SW_4 SE_4 Section 22 T. 18 S., R. 11 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
