CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWIN HOEFT

of Rt. 2, Box 108, Pendleton, State of Oregon, 97801, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Birch Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of irrigation of 99.9 acres

under Permit No. 24830 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 29, 1957 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.92 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., W. M., No. 1-1630 feet South and 260 feet West from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 27, No. 2-560 feet South and 150 feet East, No. 3-1150 feet South and 180 feet East, Hoeft Ditch-3580 feet South and 1260 feet West, all from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 34 (No. 3)

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	1.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
20.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	30.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	29.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	Section 27



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 30426, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 5, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3882. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
