This Is to Certify, That BOISE CASCADE CORPORATION

of P. O. Box 610, La Grande, State of Oregon, 97850, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-3612 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7, 1967 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.30 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 39 E., W. M., 267 feet North and 55 feet East from the SE Corner, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
