CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLIFFORD & LORRANE BABBITT

of Rt. 1, Box 92, Tygh Valley, State of Oregon, 97063, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Badger Creek

a tributary of Tygh Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 2.8 acres and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 16834 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7, 1946 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.07 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 460 feet South and 860 feet West from the NE Corner, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre~~, a diversion of not to exceed one acre foot per acre during any 30-day period up to July 1st of each year and not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; provided, that the rate of flow shall not exceed one-fortieth of a second foot per acre up to July 1st of each year and thereafter not to exceed one-eighthieth of a second foot per acre except in case of rotation.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 2.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$


This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded at Page 19560, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly describe the point of diversion and place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
