CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLARD E. HORNSCHUCK

of 2754 Labish Center Rd., Salem, State of Oregon, 97303, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Pudding River

a tributary of Big Pudding River
irrigation of 6.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28218 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, T. 6 S., R. 2 W., W. M., No. 1-160 feet South and 1720 feet West, No. 2-240 feet South and 1550 feet West, both from the NW Corner, Woodward DLC 96

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.7 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.3 acres Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 22
T. 6 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 18, 1968 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 31897, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
