for the purpose of irrigation of 21 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1881 for 151 acres; 1885 for 20 acres; 1900 for forty acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acres and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Forty acres in Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; thirty-one acres in Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter: forty acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter; twenty acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-four; thirty sores in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-six: ten acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-five, Township Nine South of Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
