## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** MIDDLE FORK IRRIGATION DISTRICT

of Parkdale, State of Oregon, 97047, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Trout Creek

a tributary of East Fork Hood River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 17.9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 17, at page 333; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 9 E., W. M., being 590 feet South and 1280 feet West from the NE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, T. 1 S., R. 10 E., W. M. (Sato Pipeline).

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



NOTE: This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by Special Order of the Water Resources Director entered January 14, 1977.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
