## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** MIDDLE FORK IRRIGATION DISTRICT

of Parkdale, State of Oregon, 97047, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of East Fork Hood River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 30.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 17, at page 333; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 9 E., W. M., being 1010 feet South and 2030 feet West from the NE corner of Section 25.


A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
20.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
3.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7  
T. 1 S., R. 10 E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
