## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879 for 60 acres: 1874 for

57.5 acres:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
