has a right to the use of

the waters of LITTLE EAGLE CREEK, ETHEL CREEK, CONUNDRES SPRING & SUMMIT CREEK, tributaries of Eagle Creek, and EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation of 173.5 acres of land,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six , at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894 for 123.5 acres: 1879 for 50 acres:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Thirty acres in Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 13.5 acres in Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; twenty acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 38.5 acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 21.5 acres in Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirteen; forty acres in Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; ten acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section twenty-seven, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.
