## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

*This Is to Certify, That*KENNETH J. WHITLOW, A GUARDIAN FOR  
RAYMOND A. WHITLOW, A MINOR

of Rt. 1, Box 57-B, Yamhill, State of Oregon, 97148, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of Hutchcroft Creek

a tributary of North Yamhill River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre in area under Permit No. 40159 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 2, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Bidwell DLC 37, Section 36, T. 2 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 1920 feet North from the SW Corner, Bidwell DLC 37

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. Description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
