CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WESTERN FISH TOXICOLOGY STATION
U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

of 1350 S.E. Goodnight Ave., Corvallis, State of Oregon, 97330, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Three Wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of water pollutions research including cultures of fish for experimental research and ponds for eutrophication research under Permit No. G-5702 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 25, 1972 for 1.34 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 1.56 c.f.s. from Well No.* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.46 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Butterfield DLC 47, Section 12, T. 12 S., R. 5 W., W. M., No. 1-578 feet North and 304 feet East; No. 2-592 feet North and 319 feet East; No. 3-583 feet North and 329 feet East, all from the SW Corner, Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
