## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Rt. 1, Box 53-A, Rogue River , State of Oregon, 97537 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of 2 unnamed streams & 3 reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-5676

a tributary of Evans Creek irrigation of 11.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35349 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 9, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per seconé, being 0.12 c.f.s. from north stream and two reservoirs and 0.02 c.f.s. from south stream and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NE4; SW4 NE4, Section 22, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.; #1-1240 feet South and 1150 feet East, #2-1080 feet South and 660 feet East, #3-1790 feet South and 530 feet East all from the N½ Corner, Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-5676;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Reservoirs 1 & 2 7.4 acres NW4 NE4 2.2 acres SW4 NE4

Reservoir 3
1.4 acres SW4 NE4
Section 22
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
