of Rt. 1, Box 1590, La Grande , State of Oregon, 97850 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed drainage ditch, spring and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6242

under Permit No. 38827 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 25, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.68 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from unnamed drainage ditch and reservoir and 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for stock use, and 0.56 c.f.s. from unnamed drainage ditch and reservoir and 0.11 c.f.s. from spring for irrigation.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW4, Section 10, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., W. M., ditch-590 feet South and 850 feet East; spring & reservoir-650 feet South and 950 feet East, both from the W4 Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6242

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

39.5 acres NE¼ SW¼ Stock - 20.0 acres NW¼ SW¼ 18.2 acres SE¼ SW¼ Section 10 T. 2 S., R. 38 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
