## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**FREDRICK C. & PEGGY C. CLAUSEN  
JOHN F. & PATRICIA R. CLAUSEN

of Rt. 1, Box 62, Dufur, State of Oregon, 97021, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of 2 springs

a tributary of Fifteenmile Creek for the purpose of stock

under Permit No. 36951 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4 gallons per minute, being 3 gpm from Spring No. 1 and 1 gpm from Spring No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., W. M., No. 1-900 feet South and 200 feet East; No. 2-1330 feet South and 500 feet East, both from the Center, Section 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
