## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**      HOMER G. & ANITA B. BAINBRIDGE

of Star Route, Box 690, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, 97116, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and Gales Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.8 acre

under Permit No. 35581 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from stream and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from creek

of its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, T. 2 N., R. 5 W., W. M., stream-300 feet North and 240 feet West; creek-120 feet South and 680 feet West, both from the NE Corner, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 0.8 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 26  
T. 2 N., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
