CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY BAUM, JR.

of 2292 S.W. Seymour Drive, Portland, State of Oregon, 97201, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6477

a tributary of West Fork Dairy Creek for the purpose of a duck pond

under Permit No. 40591 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 13, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., stream-1060 feet South and 1920 feet West; reservoir-1000 feet South and 1600 feet West, both from the NE Corner, Section 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

The right allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive use

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
