CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

of D. J. SAUNDERS, and G. B. SAUNDERS, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Richland Oregon,

for the purpose of EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for irrigation of 165 acres of land. Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878 for 70 acres; 1903 for 45 acres; 1889 for 50 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twenty-five acres in Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; fifteen acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; thirty acres in Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; five acres in Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Fifteen; ten acres in Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-four; Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
