## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of P.O. Box 800, Winchester , State of Oregon, 97495 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of maintenance of pond constructed under Permit No. R-1987 for fish culture

under Permit No. 24709 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 11, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW $_4$  NW $_4$ ), Section 26, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 300 feet South and 700 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to------of one cubic foot per second per acrc,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered February 5, 1965 and October 12, 1976 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 28828, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
