BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT DISTRICT OFFICE

of 310 West Sixth St., Medford , State of Oregon, 97501 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 2

a tributary of Jump-off Joe Creek for the purpose of use in Administration Building and supplemental irrigation of 3.0 acres

under Permit No. G-5299 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19. 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. for use in Administration Bldg., and 0.04 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NW $_4$ SE $_4$, Section 9, T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 230 feet North and 430 feet West from the SE Corner, NW $_4$ SE $_4$, Section 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Use in Administration Building & 3.0 acres NW4 SE4 Section 9
T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
