CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That.SHERMAN UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT
NO. UH1

of P.O. Box 425, Moro, State of Oregon, 97039, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Sherman High School Well

a tributary of Grass Valley Canyon
irrigation of 7.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-6540 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
July 29, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.
The well is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 17 E., W. M., 475 feet
South and 665 feet West from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:


7.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
T. 1 S., R. 17 E., W. M.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a
clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not
exceed 1/80th of one cubic foot of water per second per acre and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet
per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been
raised to 1/80th cubic foot per second per acre and 3 acre feet per acre for
each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with
the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum
limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
