of Star Route, Box 575, Forest Grove , State of Oregon, 97116 - , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of White Creek and four reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-6523

a tributary of Gales Creek irrigation of 0.3 acre and fish culture

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 40910 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 23, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Harper DLC 38, Section 36, T. 2 N., R. 5 W., W. M., No. 1-310 feet North and 1680 feet West; No. 2-370 feet North and 620 feet West, both from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish Culture & O.3 acre SE½ SW½ As projected within Harper DLC 38 Section 36
T. 2 N., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
