CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STAYTON CANNING COMPANY, COOPERATIVE

of 930 W. Washington St., Stayton, State of Oregon, 97383, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of three wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of food processing

under Permit No. G-6014 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 2, 1973 - 0.2 c.f.s. from Well No. 4 and December 13, 1973-0.7 c.f.s.\* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.9 cubic foot per second, being 0.4 c.f.s. from Well No. 1, 0.3 c.f.s. from Well No. 3, 0.2 c.f.s. from Well No. 4

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, all as projected within Cooper DLC 53, Section 9, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M., Well No. 1-350 feet North and 350 feet East; Well No. 3-530 feet South and 50 feet East; Well No. 4-470 feet South and 1750 feet West, all from the NW Corner, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
