under Permit No. 21337 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.88 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% NW%, as projected within Watt DLC 78, Section 13, T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 1590 feet East from the NW Corner, Watt DLC

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre NEW NWW 30.1 acres SE¼ NW¾ 26.6 acres NE¼ SW¾ 12.6 acres SE¼ SW¾ Section 13 All as projected within Watt DLC 78 T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 27, 1978 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 22528, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
