## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Rt. 3, Box 3210, Warren , State of Oregon, 97053 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Sly Creek

a tributary of Honeyman Creek irrigation of 97.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31951 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 15, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $\,$  NW4 NW4, Section 26, T. 4 N., R. 2 W., W.M., 920 feet South and 260 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and is subject to the time and conditions of a stipulation between the Department of Fish and Wildlife and the applicant dated January 24, 1967, and recorded in the miscellaneous records of the Water Resources Department and by reference made a part hereof,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.2 acres NE% SW%
9.5 acres NW% SW%
25.2 acres SW% SW%
26.4 acres SE% SW%

16.0 acres NE% NW%
5.2 acres NW% NW%

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
