CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MANY J. SIMONIS.

of Richland . State of

Oregon,

has a right to the use of

the waters of LITTLE EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Eagle Creak, and EAGLE CHEEK, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation of 101.6 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six , at page 291 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twelve acres in Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; sixteen acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 11.8 acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 11.8 acres in Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; eight acres in Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; twenty-nine acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; four acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter, eight acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-two. Township Wine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
