CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MERLE F. AND OR TRICIA G. BAKER

of Siletz River Rd., Siletz, State of Oregon, 97380, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and Wade Creek

a tributary of Siletz River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 4.0 acres

under Permit No. 37124 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 31, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.055 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from the unnamed spring for domestic use and 0.05 c.f.s. from Wade Creek for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, T. 9 S., R. 10 W., W. M., Wade Creek-175 feet South and 225 feet East; Unnamed spring-100 feet South and 325 feet East, both from the NW Corner, Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 4.0 acres Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 9
T. 9 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
